EGG-TASTIC BUNNY EARS!

Bring a smile to breakfast time this Easter with these great bunny egg ears!



ENCOURAGES: Construction **★** Moving & Handling

STORE CUPBOARD

- Thin white card in white, grey & pink (or paper)
- Pencil & ruler
- Scissors
- Glue stick

On a piece of white or grey thin card and using a ruler and pencil, draw a strip measuring approx. 14cm x 1cm.

In the middle of the strip draw some

rabbit ears. Ours measured approx. 5cm high. Cut out the strip including the ears and put to one side.

2 Take a scrap of pink card or paper and draw some inner ears, cut them out and using the glue stick, stick them to the outer ears on the strip. Use the picture above for guidance.

3 To complete your bunny ears, stick the two ends of the strip together to form a

circle. Draw a bunny face on an egg using a marker pen and then pop the ears on top!

ALTERNATIVES

Why not make a giant pair of bunny ears for the children to wear this Easter? Just measure the child's head, add 4cm and cut the card accordingly.

If you are making the ears for a child to wear, consider making them from coloured fun foam to give them more durability.
