



## Ghost Decoration

### STORE CUPBOARD

- White paper plate
- Black card
- White card
- White crepe paper
- Hole punch
- Thin black ribbon
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Sticky tape

## Paper Plate Spider

### STORE CUPBOARD

- Paper Plate
- Coloured card – black, red and white
- Black paint
- Paintbrush
- 2 googly eyes
- Newspaper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Sticky tape

### To make the Spider

- 1** Begin by covering your work surface with newspaper to protect from paint spills. Roll up your sleeves and wear a painting smock or apron.
- 2** Paint the back of the paper plate black. Leave the paint to dry.
- 3** When the paint is dry, stick on two googly eyes.
- 4** Cut out a smile in red card. Stick in place. Next, cut out two fangs in white card and glue onto the smile.
- 5** Finally, cut out eight legs for your spider in black card. Use sticky tape to attach the legs.

### To make the Ghost

- 1** The white paper plate will become the ghost's face. Cut out two eyes and a mouth in black card. Glue them onto the paper plate.
- 2** Use a pencil to draw two arms for your ghost in white card. Neatly cut out with scissors. Attach the arms to the ghost with sticky tape.
- 3** Cut out five 3cm wide strips of white crepe paper. Glue the strips along the bottom edge of the paper plate.
- 4** Finally, punch a hole through the top of the paper plate. Thread through a length of thin black ribbon. Knot the ribbon ends together to make a hanging loop. Your ghost decoration is now ready to hang up on display!
