These rainbow pictures make colourful designs for Mother's Day cards and once you start doodling you won't be able to stop!

STORE CUPBOARD

- Coloured pencils
- An H or 2H pencil
- Card
- Scissors

1 Lightly draw a design in the middle of the card using a hard pencil, an H or 2H is ideal, as it won't smudge. An outlined

shape or some lettering without any detail is all you need.

2 Use a selection of different coloured pencils to go over the pencil lines and start making the rainbow effect. You could make the lines thicker and add patterns around the edge.

3 Start building up the design by drawing more patterns and shading in around the outlines. Work outwards with more doodles to the edge of the card. Keep swapping your pencils round using the colours in the middle area as a guide for making the rainbow effect.

TIP

For a bold effect, press down firmly with your coloured pencils and remember to keep them sharpened.
