

CASCADE OF FLOWERS

STORE CUPBOARD

- Coloured card
- Drinking straw
- Length of ribbon
- Scissors
- Paint, felt-tip pens, glitter etc.

1 Cut out six flower shapes from coloured card, gradually decreasing in size. The children can decorate them if they wish, using paint, glitter etc.

2 Cut a drinking straw into five equal pieces and taking a length of ribbon, make a knot at one end and thread on the smallest flower followed by a length of straw.

3 Continue threading flowers in order of size with a piece of straw in between each one.

4 When you have finished threading, fold the top of the ribbon over to make a loop to hang your flowers.



Funky Fish Bowls

STORE CUPBOARD

- Clear, round yoghurt pots
- Blue acrylic paint
- Paintbrushes
- Blue & green paper & tissue paper
- Orange/green card
- Pipe cleaners
- Metallic paper scraps, sweet wrappers & sequins
- Scissors & glue
- Small pebbles & sand

1 Before you start, thoroughly wash and dry the yoghurt pots. Then paint the inside of some

of them with blue acrylic paint and allow to dry.

2 You can cover the bottom of the pots with glue and sprinkle in some play sand to make a sandy tank bottom and then add some little pebbles. Or you can scrunch up some sweet wrappers or tissue paper to look like water.

3 Cut fish shapes from orange card and cover them in glitter or sequins to make scales. Metallic card works really well too. Stick the fish onto pipe cleaners to make them look like they are swimming. Cut reeds out of green paper and stick them inside the pots.
